Two Prongs, One Vision:

Valley Vision Launches Development Arm

The Valley Vision Board of Directors is strategically strengthening VVEDC's capacity to serve the Valley with the establishment of a newly designated 501(c)3 not-for-profit entity. The vision for the new organization, Valley Vision Economic Development Authority (VVEDA), is to function as the Development Arm, working in close coordination with the existing 501(c)6 organization.

This new structure creates a powerful dual strategy for economic success:

VVEDC (501(c)6): The Sales and Marketing Engine

Your investment fuels the VVEDC (501(c)6), which serves as the primary Sales and Marketing Engine for the Valley. This core function drives all proactive business attraction, promotional outreach, investor relations, and showcasing of the Valley's assets to potential businesses looking to relocate or expand.

Through these expanded marketing efforts, VVEDC has strategically broadened its reach, focusing specifically on five key markets outside of the Valley and actively targeting seven prospecting industries.

VVEDA 501(c)3: The Development and Problem-Solving Partner

The newly formed 501(c)3 entity is positioned as the essential **problem-solving partner when property development is needed**. Its mission is to alleviate the burdens of government and combat community deterioration by tackling complex physical projects. This entity will focus on closing deals where construction development is needed, ensuring the Valley is ready and to support new investment coming to the Valley.

This separation of roles ensures that while the 501(c)6 focuses on finding a deal, the 501(c)3 is ready to secure deals by solving the challenges required to make it happen. For instance, if a prospect requires a specific industrial building (a known challenge, as identified in VVEDC's BEAR recent reports as impediments to expansions), the 501(c)3 can step in as the problem-solver to facilitate the necessary construction and development.

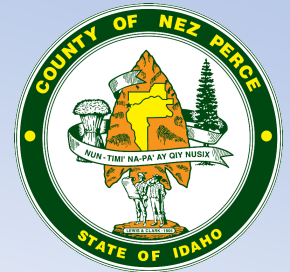
By working together, the two entities provide a complete economic development solution often found in other thriving communities, driving both external interest and internal readiness for the Valley.

- The comprehensive **Business Expansion and Retention (BEAR) findings**—a critical project funded by investor support—identified and brought to the forefront the challenges faced by existing local businesses, giving us a roadmap for corrective action to include a **Lewiston Development Satisfaction Survey** initiative. This survey will allow developers to provide direct feedback after navigating the development process, enabling us to continuously improve efficiency.
- **Influencing Infrastructure Policy:** Based directly on the BEAR findings, where manufacturers strongly advocated for continuous City investment. We commend the Lewiston City Council

for directing staff to place the crucial **downtown infrastructure bond** issue on the November ballot. When the community invests in itself, it signals a healthy and promising environment that makes convincing new companies to expand their business in the Valley significantly easier.

- **Future Readiness:** We have identified a dedicated task force to aggressively address the critical challenge of the **lack of industrial buildings in inventory** and develop a comprehensive plan for future industrial property needs. This ensures that the next multi-million dollar investment will have a site ready and waiting.
