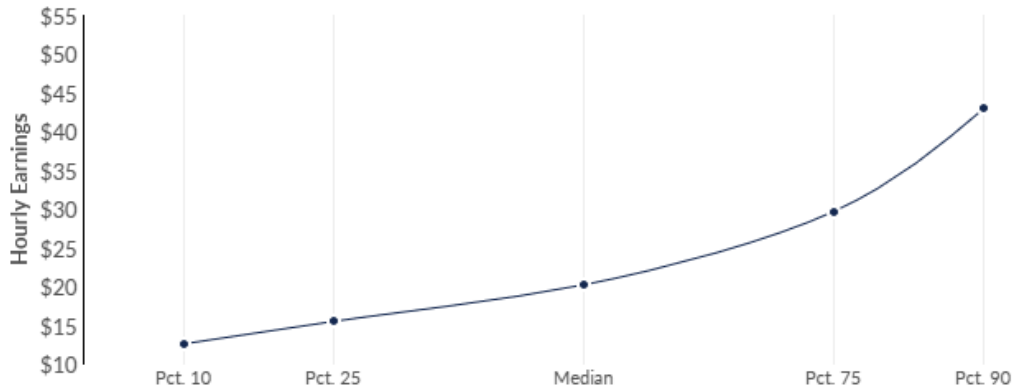

- Updated Lewiston Occupations increased by 964 from 2018-2023 (3.2%), less than the national growth rate of 3.6%. The occupations are projected to increase by 1,488 from 2023-2028 (4.8%), less than the national projected growth rate of 6.1%.
- Regional job concentration per capita for Updated Lewiston Occupations is 1.00 times the national job concentration. In other words, there are 0% more Updated Lewiston Occupations in this region than we would expect to find in the average region.
- Cost of labor in the region is below median. The median earnings for Updated Lewiston Occupations in the region is \$20.21/hr, which is \$1.65/hr below the national median of \$21.86/hr.

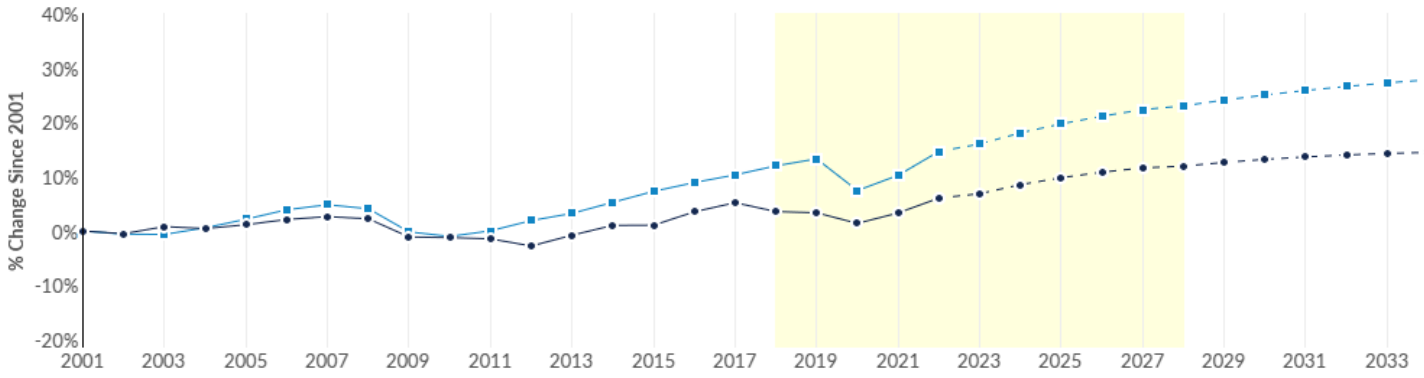
